NRSDC CALLING FOR TRANSPORT IDEAS

Have you got a burning transport issue or a transport solution that needs to be heard?

Northern Rivers Social Development Council is calling for input from local community groups and committees on ways to improve transport across the Northern Rivers.

NRSDC's Transport Development Officer, Alex Lewers said, NRSDC wants to give local groups and committees the opportunity to raise transport issues and hopefully, tap into local solutions.

"This project is focused on gathering thoughts, theories and evidence from local groups and committees that often have relevant ideas but don't have the forum to pursue them."

"We're trying to tap into the breadth of experience and knowledge which we have in the Northern Rivers and see what innovative solutions the community may have that perhaps, haven't been considered before."

Mr Lewers said he is particularly interested in ideas that address transport for disadvantaged groups and or isolated communities within the Northern Rivers.

Mr Lewers said groups or committees making submissions don't need to be dedicated to transport to take part.

"It doesn't matter what the focus of the group is or how big or small the idea. If it relates to transport we'd love to hear it."
