## TEACHING INCLUSION AWARENESS IN SCHOOLS

This inclusion awareness program is delivered over two weeks (2 x 40 - 60 min sessions).

Your facilitator is someone with lived experience of disability. They will engage children to talk about difference and the challenges faced by living with a disability.

The program provides opportunity for children to explore and discuss what it means to be inclusive of difference and to ask questions.

Students are challenged to look at their own role in society and their contribution to positive and negative mindsets, and are encouraged to find inclusive ways of communicating and acting.

This free program can be adjusted to cater for school aged children K-Y6.
