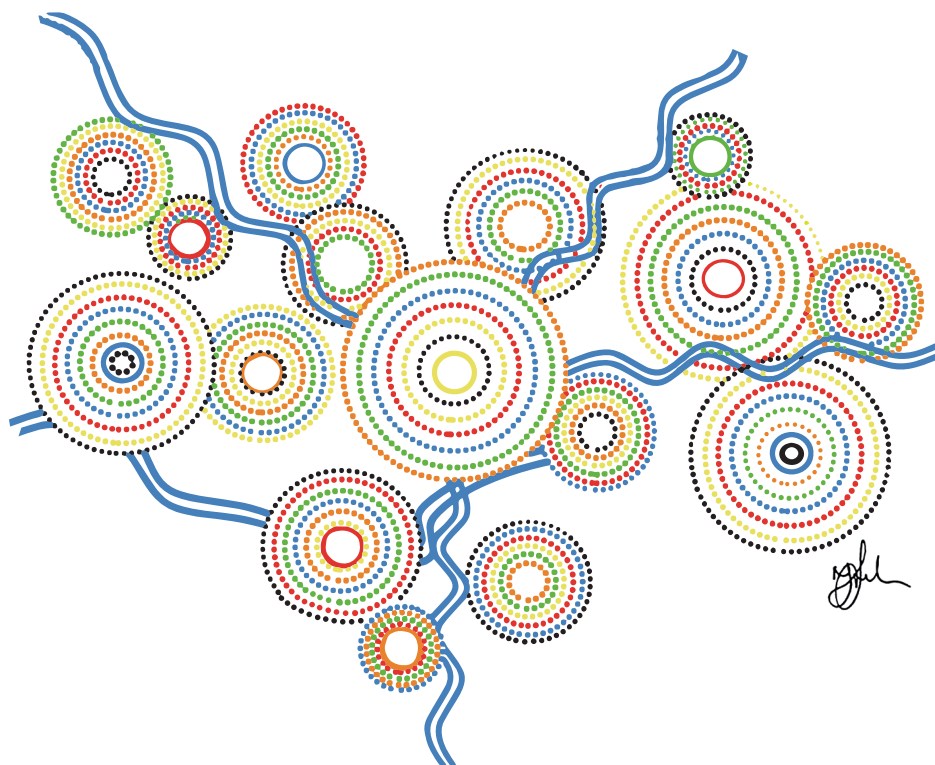


The Ripple Effect
