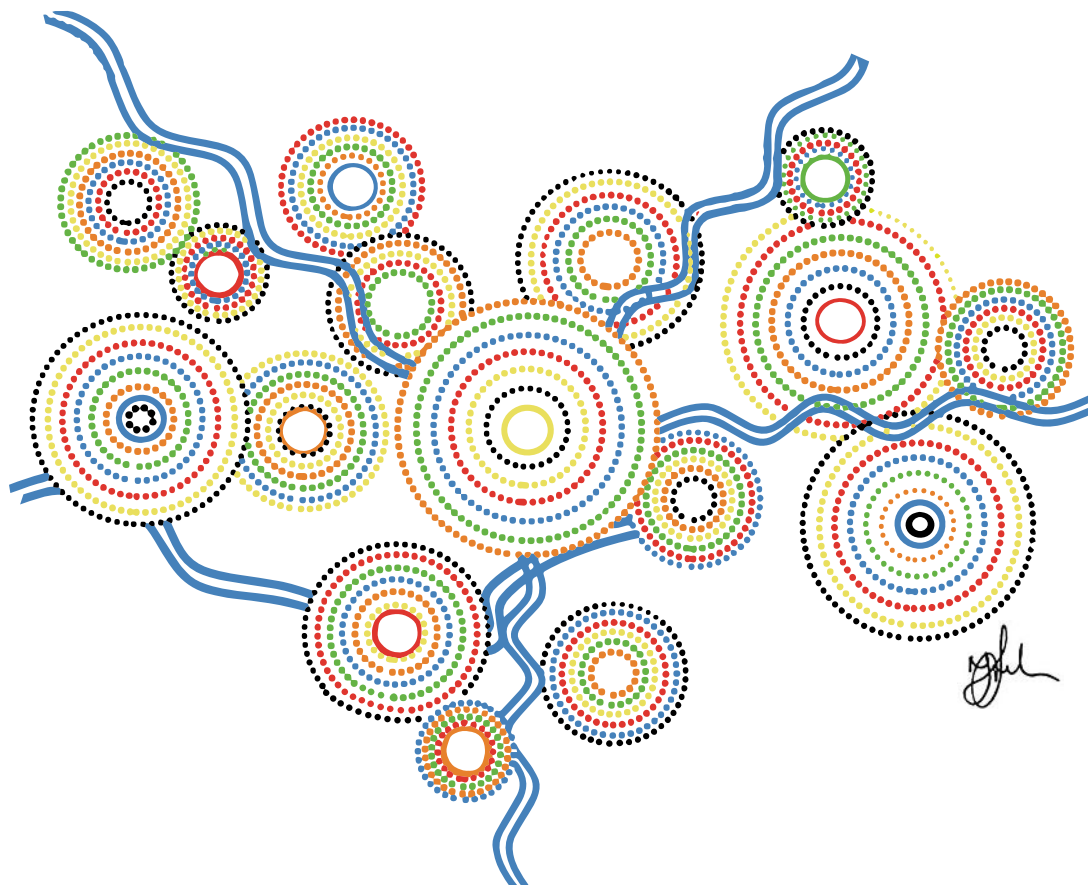


# The Ripple Effect
