I am writing on behalf of Mirri Mirri, an Aboriginal owned organization that specialises in delivering programs that educate mainstream organisations about Aboriginal people with disability.

Supported by the Department of Family and Community Services (FaCS) we are inviting representatives who manage staff from mainstream organisations to participate in **“Pathways: Creating Opportunity for Aboriginal People with Disability.”**

Research indicates the majority of people that access mainstream services are not usually from ‘at risk’ groups, such as Aboriginal people with disability, therefore staff may not be equipped to meet the extra needs of these people. Through a series of highly interactive and thought provoking activities, we aim to provide mainstream services the information and skills they need to ensure their service is accessible, inclusive and culturally safe for Aboriginal people with disability.

The program is **FREE** and comprises of a half day (3-hour) face-to-face workshop plus access to online learning resources. Key focus themes of **“Pathways: Creating Opportunity for Aboriginal People with Disability”** include:

- Increasing staff cultural awareness about Aboriginal people and specific issues relating to those with disability
- Development of strategies that aim to improve service delivery to Aboriginal people with disability.
- Becoming an employer of choice for Aboriginal people.
