What is Ability Links?

Ability Links supports people aged 7 to 64 who identify as having any type of life challenge.

The person may have a physical or intellectual disability, mental illness or medical condition. People are eligible for support if they identify as having challenges which inhibit them from achieving their goals.

- We can work with you to identify your goals and overcome any barriers in achieving those goals.
- We can advocate on your behalf, or we can refer you to specialist advocacy services.
- We can work with communities, groups and mainstream services so they are more welcoming and inclusive.
- We can work with your family, carer and friends to help you to become more confident and build new networks.
